

## **VEHICLE PREPARATION** Remove stone shield or under body 1. protection as shown, if fitted. NOTE: Retain all fasteners as these will be reused later. Check all captive nuts for damage or wear. 2. Check all 3 captive nuts are free from any foreign material. **IMPORTANT:** DO NOT FORCE BOLTS INTO NUTS. Spray lubricant into these captive nuts and test thread is clear. NOTE: If required repair holes using an Ø M10 X 1.5 tap or seek assistance from your local ARB service centre. 3. Inspect front and rear cross members for any damage or deformation. **IMPORTANT:** If either is visible, consult your nearest ARB service centre for advice.




#### FITTING PROCEDURE

	<ul> <li>IMPORTANT: Only finger tighten bolt unless otherwise specified. Torque Sequence is important for part function.</li> <li>8. Place the recovery point into position and align the bottom hole. While holding the recovery point firmly against the chassis, fasten an Ø M10 x 35 mm bolt and washer into the bottom hole of the recovery point. Note: Finger tight only</li> </ul>
<image/>	9. Fasten the front of the top bracket to the recovery point using Ø M10 x 30 mm bolt, flat washer and flange nut as shown finger tight only.
	<ol> <li>Attach the bottom of recovery point to the upper bracket with Ø M10 x 30 mm bolt, flat washer and a flange nut finger tight only.</li> </ol>

	11. Insert the larger weld nut plate through the front access slot on the right (driver) side of the front cross member.				
	12. Fit Ø M10 x 35 mm bolt and flat washer to both front bolt holes finger tight only as shown.				
Acres Acres	<ul> <li>13. Insert the small weld nut plate through the front access slot on the left (passenger) side of the front cross member.</li> <li>Note: Place flat side of weld nut plate to rear of vehicle.</li> </ul>

M <sub>10</sub> +30 M10X35	14. Fit Ø M10 x 30 mm bolt and flat washer to LHS and M10 x 35 mm bolt and flat to RHS holes finger tight only as shown.		
	<ol> <li>Insert weld single nut plates through access hole in top of the rear cross member.</li> </ol>		
	<ol> <li>Place Ø 35 mm x 8 mm spacer washers above each hole on the rear of the recovery point.</li> </ol>		
	<ol> <li>Fit Ø M10 x 45 mm bolt and flat washer to both outside holes finger tight only as shown.</li> </ol>		
18	IMPORTANT: DO NOT USE IMPACT WRENCH & DO NOT EXCEED TORQUE SPECIFICATION.		
	Torque Sequence is important for part function. Ø M10 fasteners, A 44 Nm.

	<ul> <li>26. Bolt in LWR side of FRT Cross member and REAR LHS bolts need to be removed to reinstall stone shield. <u>NOTE:</u> Refit stone shield fasteners supplied with recovery point.</li> <li>27. Refit stone shield to vehicle in reverse order to removal. <u>NOTE:</u> Some trimming to the factory stone shield may be required.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>28. Finished product fitted to vehicle (stone shield not shown).</li> <li>29. Attach the spare recovery point warning sticker in an easy to read position (I.e. The top pan on the bullbar) on the vehicle.</li> </ul>
